In addition, bids can be emailed to savas.danos@pantonmcleod.com up to the bid deadline, but sealed bids to support email submittals must be postmarked on or before the 3rd of June 2022.

As in past years, once low bids are accepted by Consortium members, all low bidder bid documents will be downloaded to the consortium web site for public viewing.
